This is a letter to state the official endorsement by the Anderson Island Citizens' Advisory Board (AICAB) of the full contents of the June 9th letter sent to you by the Anderson Island Crime Task Force asking for review of speed limits in several spots on Anderson Island. The AICAB voted at our monthly meeting on June 9th in favor of endorsing the requests contained in that letter.

To our knowledge the speed limits on the Island have not been reviewed in years. As the Island population has grown, the necessity of reminding motorists (many of whom are new to the Island) to reduce their speed seems only common sense. We specifically agree with the Crime Task Force and request that speed limits near the school, at Interlaken Park where there is heavy pedestrian traffic across a county road from a parking lot to the park, and the dangerous approach to the ferry landing be reviewed.
